WHAT ARE THE NOMINATION PROCEDURES?

Each year, members of the Pulaski Academy & Central School Alumni Association's Wall of Distinction Committee will solicit nominations through its newsletter, website and Facebook page of individuals to be considered for induction. A nomination for induction into the Pulaski Academy & Central School Alumni Wall of Distinction may be submitted by alumni, past and present faculty and staff, and members of the community.

All entries must be mailed on the official nomination form on the reverse side of this sheet. Copies are also available through the District Office and on the school website, www.pulaskicsd.org. Additional materials can be submitted along with the nomination form.

The committee will accept nominations until 9/30 of each year. Nominations will be sent to the chairperson of the Pulaski Academy & Central School Alumni Wall of Distinction. Inductees will be notified in March of the following year.

WHAT ARE THE CRITERIA FOR BEING NOMINATED?

To be eligible for consideration, the individual must have graduated from Pulaski Academy & Central School at least 10 years before the date of nomination, and must have demonstrated noteworthy or outstanding achievements.

Distinguished alumni may be nominated in one of two categories: Professional Achievement or Humanitarian Achievement.

Professional Achievement

Alumni who have distinguished themselves with excellence and acknowledged leadership in their chosen field.

Humanitarian Achievement

Alumni who have distinguished themselves with excellence and acknowledged leadership in service to the community.

Fallen Heroes

Help us recognize alumni who paid the ultimate sacrifice and lost their lives in service to our country.

Please submit information on this form to honor them on this wall and during this recognition ceremony.

Nominations need only be made one time. Those not selected for the current class of inductees will be retained for future consideration.

Operating By-laws

Pulaski Academy and Central School Alumni of Distinction Award

- I. PURPOSE**
- The Pulaski Academy and Central School Alumni of Distinction Award is being established to honor and memorialize Pulaski Academy and Central School graduates who have proved to be positive role models for past, present, and future students during their lives after graduation.

- II. LOCATION**
- A public display of plaques honoring each of the inductees will be maintained within the Pulaski Junior – Senior High School building and on both the Alumni and PACS websites.

- III. INDUCTION AND CRITERIA FOR SELECTION**
- To be eligible for consideration and induction, the individual must have graduated from Pulaski Academy and Central School at least 10 years from the date of nomination, and demonstrated noteworthy or outstanding professional or humanitarian achievements (i.e. distinguished alumni), or have paid the ultimate sacrifice and lost his/her life in the service of our country (i.e. fallen hero).

- IV. SELECTION COMMITTEE**
- The Selection Committee will include all members of the Pulaski Academy and Central School Alumni of Distinction Committee. The committee will consist of 7 voting members: 5 alumni (1 of which is member of the Alumni Executive Committee), 1 current student, 1 retired teacher. The Chair of the committee shall be appointed by the President of the PACS Alumni Association and must be an alumnus. Members of this committee shall be approved yearly by the executive committee of the Pulaski Academy and Central School Alumni Association.
